Dear Dancers and Parents,

The Youth Dance program first term continues until Saturday, January 28, 2012. The second term will run from January 30<sup>st</sup> - May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012. If you pre-registered for term 2 in the fall, your cheque will be processed on or shortly after February 1<sup>st</sup>. If you have not pre-registered but plan to continue with term 2, please send in your registration to the address above so that it is received before the end of the month. In order not to exclude any children from the program because of financial restraints, those wishing to divide second term payment of fees over \$200 into two installments may pay half by Feb 1 and postdate a cheque to April 1, 2012 for the other half of the total fee. There will be a **late registration fee of \$20 fee per applicant after February 1<sup>st</sup>** unless other arrangements have been made. A refund of tuition minus a \$20 administrative fee is possible **only** if it is requested immediately after the first class taken in the term. After that, refunds are available for medical reasons only.

In some of the classes, there may be a few spaces available to new students. Contemporary African 1 will have an "Invite a Friend" day on Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup> as we would love to encourage more students age 12 and older to try the class. There will also be a workshop in African Dance for adults on Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup>.
